## FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK



You may have heard the bells ringing again at our church. That reminds me so much of my days in Catholic schools. Bells and the Catholic Church seem to be made for each other. Our bells will chime after each Mass on the weekends and on weekdays for the Angelus. The **ANGELUS** (Latin for *Angel*) is a Christian devotion that has been in practice by the Church since the 11<sup>th</sup> century. The bells are rung and a short prayer recited 3 times a day, at morning (traditionally at 6:00AM but the bells here will ring at 8:00AM so we do not wake the neighbors ☺), noon (12:00PM) and evening (6:00PM). This devotional is meant to remind us of the Incarnation, that moment in history when Christ took on our human flesh. The name is derived from its opening line in Latin: **Angelus Domini nuntiavit Maria** (The Angel of the Lord declared unto Mary), and is prayed by reciting a verse and response taken from three Biblical verses describing the mystery of how God became Man. So if you are at church and hear the bells ring, or wherever you are at those times, take a moment to thank God for humbling Himself by praying this devotional. The devotion is as follows:

**V.** The Angel of the Lord declared to Mary. **R.** And she conceived by the Holy Spirit.

**V.** Behold the handmaid of the Lord. **R.** Be it done unto me according to Thy word.

**V.** And the Word was made flesh. **R.** And dwelt among us.

**Let us pray:** We beseech you O Lord, pour your grace into our hearts, that as we have known the Incarnation of your Son Jesus Christ by the message of an angel, so by His Cross and Passion we may be brought to the glory of His Resurrection; through the same Christ our Lord.  
**Amen.**

(One Hail Mary may be recited after each Verse/Response)
